






Mirror #24, NYC, 2002 silver gelatin print  $14 \times 11$  inches (35.6 x 27.9 cm)








Mirror #4, Sag Harbor, 1994 silver gelatin print  $14 \times 11$  inches (35.6  $\times$  27.9 cm)









